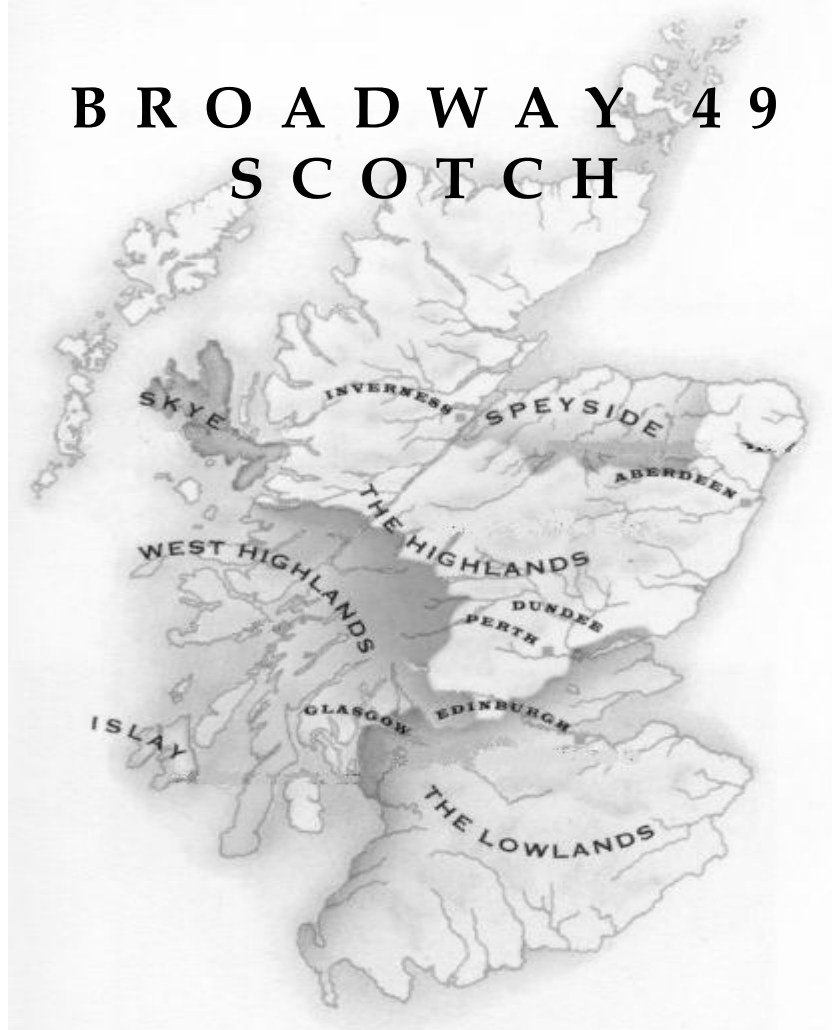


BROADWAY 49 SCOTCH



HIGHLANDS

The Highlands region is the largest by far, and the single malts produced there vary widely. It can be further subdivided into the Northern, Eastern, Western, and Central regions.

SPEYSIDE

The Speyside region is geographically located within the Highlands, but the Speyside distilleries are all adjacent to the River Spey, and they are thought to have sufficiently unique characteristics to warrant a region of their own. This region boasts the highest concentration of distilleries, and the whiskies they produce are known for their sweetness and their complex and elegant flavors and aromas.

LOWLAND

There are not many Lowland distilleries, but they have always been known for making single malts much lighter and mellower than other Scotch whiskies.

ISLAY

Islay (pronounced "eye-la") is a small island off the western coast of Scotland, and it is home to the heaviest, strongest-flavored, smokiest, and most challenging of the single malts. Some love their complexity and robustness. Their strong flavor is thought to be due to the Islay region's exposure to the high winds and seas of the west coast.

CAMPBELTOWN

Positively the smallest malt region. It is located on the Kintyre peninsula. At one time this region had 30 distilleries, today it has two.

Whether you prefer the smoky scotches of Islay or the sweetness of the Speyside's, you are sure to find something to your liking.

H I G H L A N D S

- Aberfeldy 12 Year** 13
A nose of honey and incense with soft flavors hinting of Seville oranges.
- Aberfeldy 21 Year** 27
Hints of vanilla, heather and citrus linger on the palate.
- Balblair 16 Year** 15
Clean, fresh spiciness with a light nutty fragrance; mid-amber with gold highlights.
- Dalmore 12 Year** 13
A silken, malty scotch. Flavors of spiced fruit merge nicely with a hint of Oloroso sherry and a marmalade aroma.
- Dalmore 28 Year** 35
Bursts with a rare and balanced spectrum of full, rich flavors that vigorously intermingle with ample overtones of vanilla and caramel.
- Glengoyne 12 Year** 16
A more subtle, complex whisky in which all of the delicate flavors are freely allowed to express themselves.
- Glengoyne 17 Year** 20
Medium gold color with notes of sherry and Christmas pudding. Plenty of fruit. Malty with a slightly nutty long, rich finish.
- Glenmorangie Original**
15
Bright color with a hint of pale blue, it's aroma is light, delicate and floral with a subtle smokiness for a well balanced, fresh and aromatic flavor.
- Glenmorangie 18 Year**
20
This mature malt has a full walnut and vanilla nose, with a fleshy palate of spice, wood and peat. The finish is firm, dry and nutty.
- Glenmorangie Lasanta 12 Year**
16
Elegant and full bodied with luscious mouth filling texture. There are key flavor notes of toffee, raisins and walnut.
- Glenmorangie Quinta Ruban**
17
Maturation in ruby port pipes develops this scotch into a smooth spirit with a balance of sweet and dry flavors. There are dominant tastes of mint and chocolate.
- Glenmorangie Nectar D'or** 18
Extra matured in Sauterne wine barriques. Toasted oak and vanilla

are woven with sumptuous lemon and syrup flavors finishing with delicate hints of nutmeg and ginger.

Glenmorangie Signet

60

A fusion of the company's rarest and most ancient whiskies of utmost exclusivity and unique ingredients. The rich creamy characters are complemented by flavors of delicious roast mocha coffee and bitter-sweet nutty biscuit. A voluptuous scotch indeed!

Oban 14 Year

17

Clean nose of dried herbs, chardonnay and a supposed whiff of sea breezes. Grainy texture with a warm, toffee finish.

Oban 18 Year

29

combination of rich, nutty toffee balanced by polished oak, salt, pepper, seaweed, distant smoke and dried fruit

Old Pulteney 12 Year

13

Dry, medium bodied and smooth with a clean, dry finish: faintly salty with a slight sherry note.

Old Pulteney 21 Year

20

Sweet to start with a light fruitiness; hints of honey and vanilla followed by a dry finish.

S P E Y S I D E

Aberlour Double Cask 12 Year

13

Amber gold with ruby highlights, good sherried body with fruity aromas; very soft and rounded with fruity notes.

Balvenie Double Wood Finish 12 Year

14

Distinct sweet orange in the nose with some peat. The palate smacks of honey and sherry, while the finish is reminiscent of bourbon.

Balvenie 15 Year

16

Luscious and mellow with honey, chestnut, honeysuckle and cream. Builds beautifully, with firm wood.

Balvenie Port Wood Finish 21 Year

37

A refined malt, creamy and smooth with fruit, honey and spice notes. The extra aging provides depth and dryness which dovetails nicely with port notes, turning nutty and dry on the finish. Very sophisticated.

Balvenie 30 Year

118

Silky smooth and honeyed on the nose with mellow oaky tones and hints of candied orange peel. Hints of plum marzipan and chocolate

Cragganmore 12 Year

14

Silky, elegant and rich. Currant bushes, sweet fruits, honey, cream, leather, rich malt, chestnut. Water makes it smokier. Fruity with a savory edge.

Cragganmore Cask Strength 29 Year

77

Orange peel, smoke, light leather, burnt toast, plum. Has depth and at the same time is very precise.

Dalwhinnie 15 Year 15
Delicate and spicy, with unmistakable grain and vegetable associations.

The Singleton of Glendullan 12 Year
13

Old gold coloring with light to medium body and fragrant notes of scented leather, sandalwood and vanilla. Pleasantly sweet throughout.

Glenburgie 25 Year 50
Pale straw in color with golden highlights, sweet woody aroma, with a touch of perfume and floral notes. Spicy notes and a slight burnt wood character, followed by a long, smooth, gently smoky finish.

Glenfiddich 12 Year 15
A golden, delightful malt full of oak, apricot and vanilla bean.

Glenfiddich Solera Reserve 15 Year
17
Sherry cask aged with tastes of clover, fruit, and a finish of burnt sugar.

Glenfiddich 18 Year 20
A chocolaty malt with balanced apple and wood flavors.

Glenfiddich 30 Year 95
Seductively woody, with substantial oakiness and lush notes of sherry. Woody essence, with sweet floral top notes, is savored until the final fading moments of a honeyed finish. Rare and indulgent.

The Glenlivet 12 Year
15
Clean, sweet nose of Bartlett pear, vanilla, rum and oak. Creamy texture.

The Glenlivet 15 Year
16
Well structured, with tastes of ripe mango and cinnamon. Long floral finish.

The Glenlivet 18 Year
22
Tastes of rich toffee on the palate with overtones of pecan and spice.

The Glenlivet 21 Year
30
Creamy texture with multi layered aromas of fruit and a lingering finish.

The Glenlivet Vintage 1969 100
Superbly balanced with clean and precise Sherry flavoring. A dry, oaky start; malty; saltiness shows quite early. Intense malt finish with a bittersweet and chewy finale. There are also notes of dates, figs, allspice and cinnamon as well as baked pineapple and mint.

The Glenlivet Vintage 1972 70
Lovely glowing color. Syrupy-sweet. Firm. Fruit and nuts in bitter chocolate. Toasted nuts. Slight woody bitterness. Enough to balance the sweetness, but too little to offend. A big Glenlivet, more robust than complex.

- The Glenlivet Nàdurra Cask Strength 16yr** 19
Pale gold in color with an intense nose. Fruity with lemon and notes of creamy praline. Crisp and fresh, fruity and herbal. Superbly balanced.
- Glenrothes Select Reserve** 18
A noble and complex malt with a deep, fruity nose, a medium to full body and a well rounded, raisiny palate. It is beautifully balanced, with a smooth dryness in the finish.
- Glenrothes 1975** 65
The nose is nutty and fruity, in particular oranges, with herbal and vanilla notes. Rich and spicy on the palate, with more vanilla, grapefruit and hazelnuts. The finish is lengthy and medium sweet.
- Glenrothes 1985** 26
A delicious blend of fruits, honey and spices emerge in the mouth, with smooth heather, prunes and refined oak notes. Vanilla and brittle toffee feature in the elegant and lengthy finish.
- Glenrothes 1991** 23
Autumn gold in color. With a rich mature aroma and notes of berry fruits, vanilla and white chocolate with a long sweet finish.
- Macallan 12 Year** 15
The nose is distinctly sherried, accompanied by toffee and cloves. Dried fruit and spice flavor on the palate with a medium long finish.
- Macallan 18 Year** 28
Burnished mahogany color, a nose of rich, dried fruit and Spanish wood oak with traces of nutmeg. The palate is smoky and resinous.
- Macallan 25 Year** 58
Concentrated citrus peels and ripe fruit with a chocolate and heather palate and an elegant, crystalline ginger finish. Mature and defined.
- Tamdhu 10 Year** 11
A good, light-to-medium malt, which is slightly peaty but with a delicate sweetness and a long, subtle finish. A great introduction to Scotch for the beginner.
- Tormore 12 Year** 14
Gentle citrus notes and toasted almonds. Smooth and soft, a subtle citrus tang balanced with subtle spices, dry. Rounded, long lasting and complex.

- Auchentoshan 12 Year**
15
Toasted almonds and caramelized toffee; smooth and delicate.
- Glenkinchie 12 Year** 15
Sweet nose, well balanced, hints of lemon, herbs, and malt.

I S L A Y

- Ardbeg**
16
Amber with pale gold highlights; big-bodied, dark and pungent, solid peat character and a hint of sweetness. Long, tangy and pungent finish.

Bowmore 12 Year 14

Amber; more salt, seaweed and smoke than at 10 years. Medium, lightly syrupy. Remarkably long and salty finish.

Bowmore 25 Year 65

Deep rich mahogany color with a nose of intense sherry and stewed fruits with a trace of smokiness. The palate is a delicious blend of toffee and hazelnut mellowed with sweet peat smoke.

Bruichladdich 10 Year
10

Light, fresh and full of vitality. Assertive youthful bouquet with honeysuckle, myrtle, green apple, garden mint, dry hay and oak shavings, salt and crushed sea shells. Simple and succulent. The finish is full of action.

Bruichladdich 12 Year
14

Flavors of warm vanilla, mellow oak and soft exotic fruits

Bruichladdich 15 Year
22

Toffee, butterscotch overture, followed by vanilla, citrus and apricots, with a final touch of malt, and underlying toastiness. Ultra-delicate, creamy, apricots and hints of orange. Elegant and seductive.

Bruichladdich 1973 74

Light gold in color. Very complex aroma: flowers and peels, caramelized fruits, nuts and vanilla. American oak casks allowed the malt to mature over a very long period without overwhelming.

Bruichladdich Rocks 16

Soft red grapes, pomegranate and red apple all encased in an envelop of syrup, sweet malted barley and vanilla. The wine flavors wait patiently while the malt and oak display- bringing a cherry, strawberry spiciness.

Bunnahabhain 12 Year
13

The nose offers a fresh and aromatic experience with a subtle whiff of smoke floating through the air. The taste starts with a light fruit and nut appeal that leads to a malty sweetness, finishing into a beautifully rich full-bodied, lingering experience.

Bunnahabhain 18 Year
22

This beautiful golden spirit's nose releases honeyed nuts and a slightly sea-induced salty tang. Rich toffee and leathery oak aromas can be sensed upon further inspection.

Caol Ila 12 Year
16

Pale straw in color. A subdued nose with citric fruitiness. A little water raises almond oil and old-fashioned oilskins. Firm and light to medium body with a sweet smokiness and slightly sour finish.

Lagavulin 16 Year 19

Outstanding aromas of peat and salt. A rounded sherry palate with lasting flavors of tea, burnt chocolate and espresso.

Lagavulin Distiller's Edition 15Year
22

Deep gold in color, with big flavor. Begins with sweetness and ends with peat, smoke and hints of seaweed. Incredibly long smooth and rounded finish

Laphroaig 10 Year 14

Pungent, earthy aroma of blue peat smoke, nutty barley and heather.

Laphroaig Quarter Cask 19

Autumn gold in color with a slightly peaty nose. Adding water will release smooth velvety coconut creamy aroma. There is a creamy zesty orange finish.

C A M P B E L T O W N

Glen Scotia 12 Year 22

A very nice nose, spicy with some sherry hints and hay smell in the background. The mouth confirms the nose with spiciness and clear chocolate notes with a warm finish.

Springbank 10 Year 17

The nose suggests a wide range of aromas, from citrus fruits to pears and a hint of peat, the palate excites even further with a touch of smoke, vanilla essence, nutmeg, cinnamon and the salty tang.

T H E I S L E S

Arran 10 Year 14

From the Isle of Arran. Ripe golden barley; the initial rush of vanilla sweetness gives way to the fruits of slow distillation.

Jura 16 Year 13

From the Isle of Jura. Soft peaches and honey with a hint of citrus and marzipan will slowly arise, yet the backbone of its heritage continues to ebb away on the aftertaste, leaving the palate rewarded and satisfied.

Highland Park 12 Year

13

From the Orkney Isles. Heather-honey sweetness; peaty smokiness. Rounded smoky sweetness; full malt delivery. Teasing, heathery, subtle smoke finish. Delicious.

Scapa 14 Year 14

From the Orkney Isles. Perfectly balanced wild honey and heather, delicate spices. Very rich and long finish with a distinct dry aftertaste.

Tobermory 10 Year 12

From the Isle of Mull. Fresh, lightly peated, smoky nose prevails. The pleasantly surprising taste profile is medium dry with a smooth and fruity tang.

T H E I S L E O F S K Y E

Talisker 10 Year

17

From the Isle of Skye. Peat-smoke with sea-water saltiness, the liquor of fresh oysters, a citrus sweetness. A rich dried-fruit sweetness with clouds of smoke and strong barley-malt flavors, warming and intense.

Talisker 25 Year

50

Bright olive gold in color. Sweet and meek to start, with some acidity and saltiness. Extraordinary flavor development.

J A P A N E S E W H I S K Y

Suntory Yamazaki Single Malt Whisky 12 Year

15

This is a medium-bodied whisky with the aromas of dried fruits and honey. It has a delicate, mellow taste with a lingering, woody, dry finish.

Suntory Yamazaki Single Malt Whisky 18 Year

19

This is a full-bodied whisky with spicy cherry-like tones. The toffee aromatics of this copper-gold colored whisky offer a pleasant, long, dry finish.

A blend containing only single malt scotches; vibrant, fresh and smooth.

22

Creamy and honeyed flavors on the palate.

Has a velvety smooth mouth feel and an explosion of flavors.
